





 \rightarrow Secretariat elaborates information tools for regions





DORIS_NET and RCO's

- DORIS_NET (Downstream Observatory organised by Regions active In Space - Network) NEREUS-flagship project
- Consortium comprises 13 NEREUS-partners
- Core outcome: Creation of a network of GMES Regional Contact Offices (RCOs) whose mission is to stimulate and facilitate the exchange GMES expertise, data, services and best practice across and between regions
- 6 RCO's in NEREUS-regions: Azores region (SRCTE), Bremen, East Midlands region (G-STEP), Lombardia (CNR-IREA), Midi-Pyrenees/ Aquitaine (CETE Sud-Ouest), Basilicata (TERN)
- Part of the GMES4Regions initiative powered both by DORIS_Net and the parallel project GRAAL
 - SUSTAINABILITY of RCO's structure one of major challenges 2013/2014......



THE ISSUE

- THE ISSUE: Traffic- Health-Environment- Intelligent Solutions Sustaining Urban Economies –
- Funded within the EC Regions of Knowledge project of the EU FP-7-program
- Consortium comprises research clusters from 5 NEREUS-regions (East Midlands, Molise, Mazovia, Midi-Pyrenees and Aquitaine Regions
- Creation of a vibrant partnership of regional research clusters to bring together and coordinate already-existing and projected RTD programmes relevant to "THE" both within the clusters and more widely in the broader European research community



ERASMUS-Project Proposal (1)

 12 day masters level summer school to train students from partner institutes in the principles of Earth observation with applications to land, atmospheric and ocean monitoring

Objectives

- Increase student awareness and exposure to Earth observation research and industry, including practical experience of specialist software and tools for the analysis of satellite data
- Encourage interdisciplinary and collaborative approaches to solving Earth observation problems in different market and social sectors.



Voice of European regions - Advocate of Regions for matters of space uses (1)

- In 2011 two NEREUS-position papers with the respect to the future funding of Europe's space programs, in particular GMES
- NEREUS contributed its position to opinion of the CoR to the EC Communication "TOWARDS A SPACE STRATEGY FOR THE EUROPEAN UNION THAT BENEFITS ITS CITIZENS"
- NEREUS input to report by MEP Marian Jean Marinescu Proposal for a regulation on the implementation and exploitation of European satellite navigation systems (vote scheduled for 19/12/12)



Voice of European regions - Advocate of Regions for matters of space uses (2)

- Panel Debate on the occasion of the Toulouse Space Show, 26/06/2012: "Europe's Regions a greenhouse for developing space applications?" - reflecting on the role of regions as political and economic decision makers to promote the development of space applications and services across Europe
