- ➤ Mandate: Promote and facilitate cooperation in space related education activities between European regions (dissemination, networking and projects)

- ➤ An ERASMUS Project on "FORmation of Multi-disciplinary Approaches to Training in Earth Observation" ("Summer School" from 19th til 31st July 2013) *completed*
- ➤ Brochure "Space Education and Training Examples from NEREUS Regions"_- completed
- ➤ NEREUS Education and Training website/ e-catalogue
- ➤ Triggered answers to RFP H2020 COMPET 10
 - One proposal submitted, "Space Youth-Tube Challenge or SPACE IT UP"
 Gathering European space centres to create awareness among teens for space related science;
 - Rejected, although very high score (4,5/5 excellence, 5/5 impact)







Actions in line with NEREUS President Agenda

As there are...

- Increase a sound demand from administrative bodies and citizens for space services
- Strengthen relationships with other space related networks (and ESA)
- Outline European policies in HORIZON 2020
- Increase the visibility of the network





Actions in 2014/15

- > Space Girls developing a framework, timetable and guidance for the exhibition
- Use HORIZON 2020 for further CET projects/activities
 - Exploring the upcoming work programme in spring 2015 (check relevant calls)
 - e.g. Integrated Society in Science and Innovation, ideas of a space awareness European SpaceBus
 - Drafting calls that are missing in the programme so far (Space Literacy, Women in Space...)
- Increasing the visibility of space application:
 - Organising in 2016 a Day without Satellites in NEREUS regions/in Europe
- E-catalogue developing further with partners (ESA, space agencies, others)
- ➤ In general: Attract new and more members for the WG; may be CET name is misleading (no real "C" activity). We feel the need is to promote the use of space and to support education. Why not "Space Education and Awareness"
