



#### 100% basic broadband coverage achieved across Europe – EU target achieved ahead of schedule. Next stop is fast broadband for all.

Every EU household can now have a basic broadband connection, thanks to pan-EU availability of satellite broadband. Satellite connections are now available in all 28 countries meaning every European can take out a satellite subscription, including the three million people not already covered by fixed and mobile broadband networks.





## **11 thematic objectives**






## **3 Authorities for each Programme:**

- A managing authority to implement the operational programme, and a monitoring committee to oversee it.
- A certification body to verify the statement of expenditure and the payment applications before their transmission to the Commission.
- An auditing body for each operational programme to supervise the efficient running of the management and monitoring system.
