

ASI APPROACH

- Space activities, managed in Italy by ASI, are becoming of great interest for local actors and Regions in particular
- Regions are, indeed, subjects able to aggregate the demand and to represent laboratories for the use of space services, as well as to boost the development of small and medium companies (SMEs)
- The principle to follow, according to the Smart Specialization Strategy (S3), is to focus on specific strengths of territories
- To this purpose, ASI is engaged in specific agreements with a first list of Italian Regions
- The space application segment is a major force for generating wealth and employment and SMEs are a major element within it
- In this scenario, ASI intends to support especially Italian SMEs in order to stimulate awareness in new communities of users (including local public administration), creating added value through exploitation and combination of existing space assets.



OTHER ASI INITIATIVES

- ASI is also engaged in a 3 years cooperation agreement with the national space industry associations to promote an industrial policy toward SMEs
- At national level 4 thematic Invitations to Tender (ITTs) have been issued for SMEs in 2009-2014 and special attention is paid to services and applications.
- Moreover ASI is going to issue an open call, reserved to Italian SMEs, for the use of data of COSMO Sky-Med with the aim of improving existing applications and developing new technologies.
