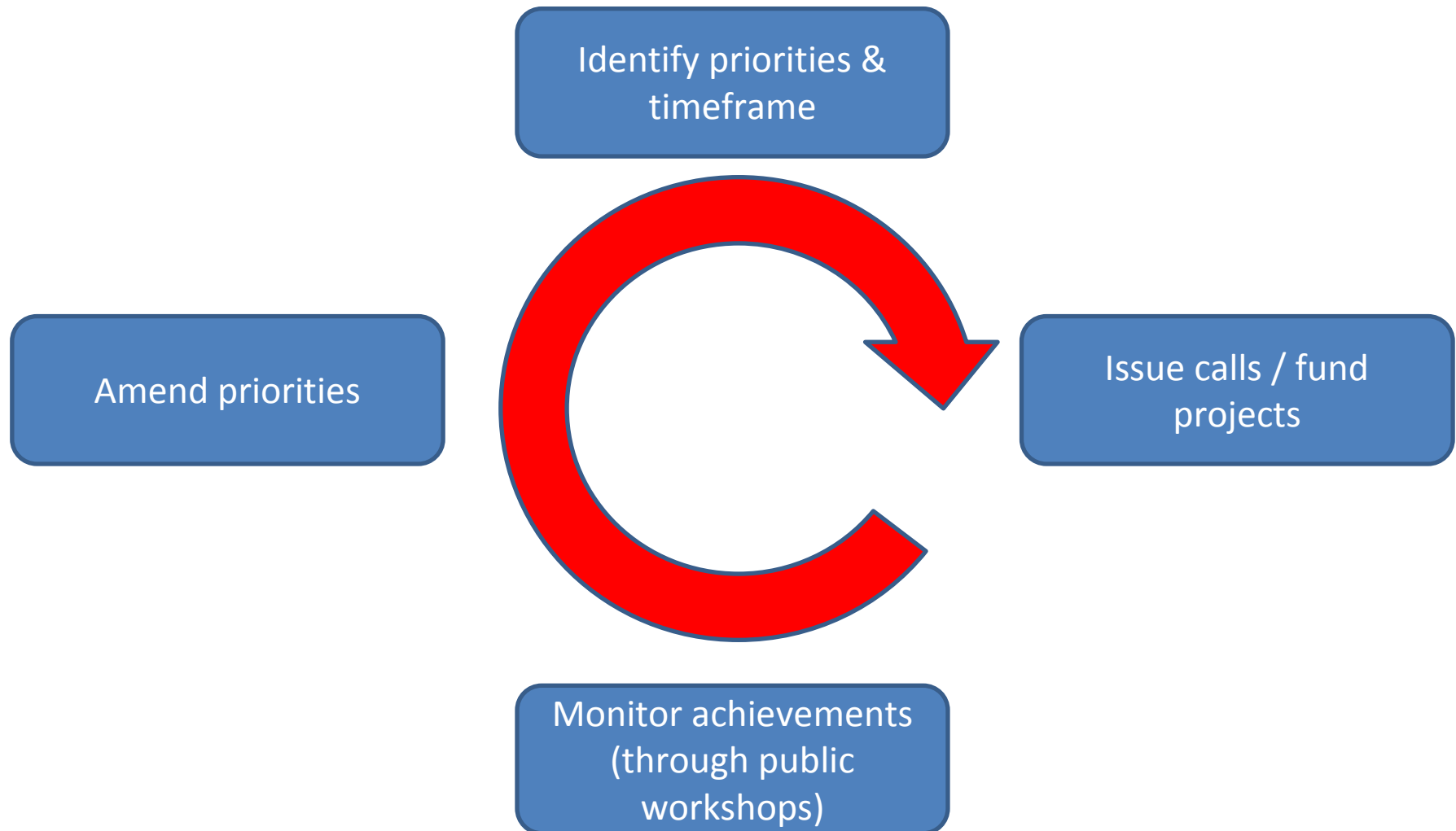


Cycle of application

- Dublin
 - Improvement of situational awareness
- Valencia
 - Continuity of logistic chain – currently a fragmented approach due to lack of exchange of information among ports (due to commercial reasons) – Interoperability (SCUTUM project completed) - intermodality
 - Tracing of dangerous goods for prevention / detection of hazardous incidents
 - Automated container terminals
- Venice
 - Dangerous goods management
 - Harmonisation of port operation-ship position-customs
 - The port to function as the interface between sea – land transportation system
- Legislation complexity (harmonisation among EU – outside EU countries); initiatives underway (e.g. by DG Mare)
- Identify how technological applications can support policy making
